Pacific Historic Parks supports the National Park Service through research, preservation, restoration, fund development, education and interpretive programs of World War II in the Pacific and other Pacific historic sites.

Established in 1979, Pacific Historic Parks is a 501(c)(3), tax exempt cooperating association committed to preserving the legacy of our historic heritage by providing support of research, preservation, restoration, education, and interpretive programs to the National Park Service at World War II Valor in the Pacific National Monument (Pearl Harbor), War in the Pacific National Historical Park (Guam), American Memorial Park (Saipan), Kalaupapa National Historical Park (Molokai) and Diamond Head State Monument (Oahu).

Like most years, fiscal year 2017 had its share of challenges, ups and downs, surprises and disappointments. But as a new year dawns, we at Pacific Historic Parks look forward to preserving historic sites of reflection and peace, providing and supporting educational opportunities for children and visitors from around the world, and enhancing interpretive, restoration and research programs that fulfill our mission to Remember, Honor and Understand the sacrifices of our “greatest generation.”

Nearly 12,000 Pearl Harbor and World War II Survivors and their families gathered on the 75th anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor to honor the sacrifice and dedication of our “Greatest Generation” both civilian and military. December 7, 1941 – a “date which will live in infamy,” thrust America into World War II, changed our country forever and continues to define our world today. Beginning with the 75th year and for several years to come, as a community we will have a number of opportunities to come together to remember and commemorate significant engagements that took place in the Pacific Theater that secured peace in our time.

One of our goals is to transform our educational outreach to touch the hearts and minds of new generations, and inspire them to keep history alive. In collaboration with our partners (the National Park Service and the State of Hawaii), a Virtual Reality tour was launched at the World War II Valor in the Pacific National Monument - Pearl Harbor, an educational module was shared with every 4th grader at the War in the Pacific National Historical Park (Guam) and American Memorial Park (Saipan), vital natural resources restoration continued at Kalaupapa National Historical Park, and an interpretive narrated tour was created for our visitors at Diamond Head State Monument. Throughout the coming year and beyond, Pacific Historic Parks will continue to support initiatives, to teach and inspire our children to be better leaders and stewards of the legacy of World War II in the Pacific.

As we continue into a new year, I would like to acknowledge the ongoing commitment and dedication of the Pearl Harbor Survivors and other World War II veterans who grace us with their presence, our Board of Directors, staff, volunteers, and friends. Thank you for your continuing contributions, support, and accomplishments.

HONORING THE PAST, INSPIRING THE FUTURE

the poignant theme of the 75th anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor resonated as visitors gathered to honor and pay tribute to the legacy of the Greatest Generation.

More than 10,000 people including more than 200 Pearl Harbor Survivors and World War II Veterans made the long journey from all across our nation to commemorate this anniversary to honor the sacrifice and dedication of our Greatest Generation. This was a time of reflection, remembrance and commitment. They participated in 50 events, public and private, including the National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day Commemoration at Kilo Pier. Five thousand were in attendance there, with an additional 3,000 viewed the live stream at the Pearl Harbor Visitor Center.

One of Pacific Historic Parks' goals to fulfill its mission is to reach out across the generations to honor the past and inspire the future by leveraging current technology, emerging communication platforms to reach a larger global audience.

PHP was able to present to Pearl Harbor Survivors and World War II Veterans the first view of our Virtual Reality mobile app of the USS *Arizona* Memorial. This enables the sharing of history with people around the world who might not have the opportunity to experience Pearl Harbor in person.

This includes interactive educational exhibits available onsite, online, and through mobile devices; as well as a migration to an interactive, guided tour, and a smart searchable online national database. This also provides the National Park Service (NPS) with a foundation for future content management, public access, and ongoing education.

The majority of PHP's resources, staff, and financial assistance is spent throughout the year to support the parks through research, preservation, restoration, education, and interpretive programs of World War II Valor in the Pacific National Monument (VALR), Honouliuli National Monument, War in the Pacific National Historical Park (Guam), American Memorial Park (Saipan), Kalaupapa National Historical Park (Molokai), and Diamond Head State Monument.

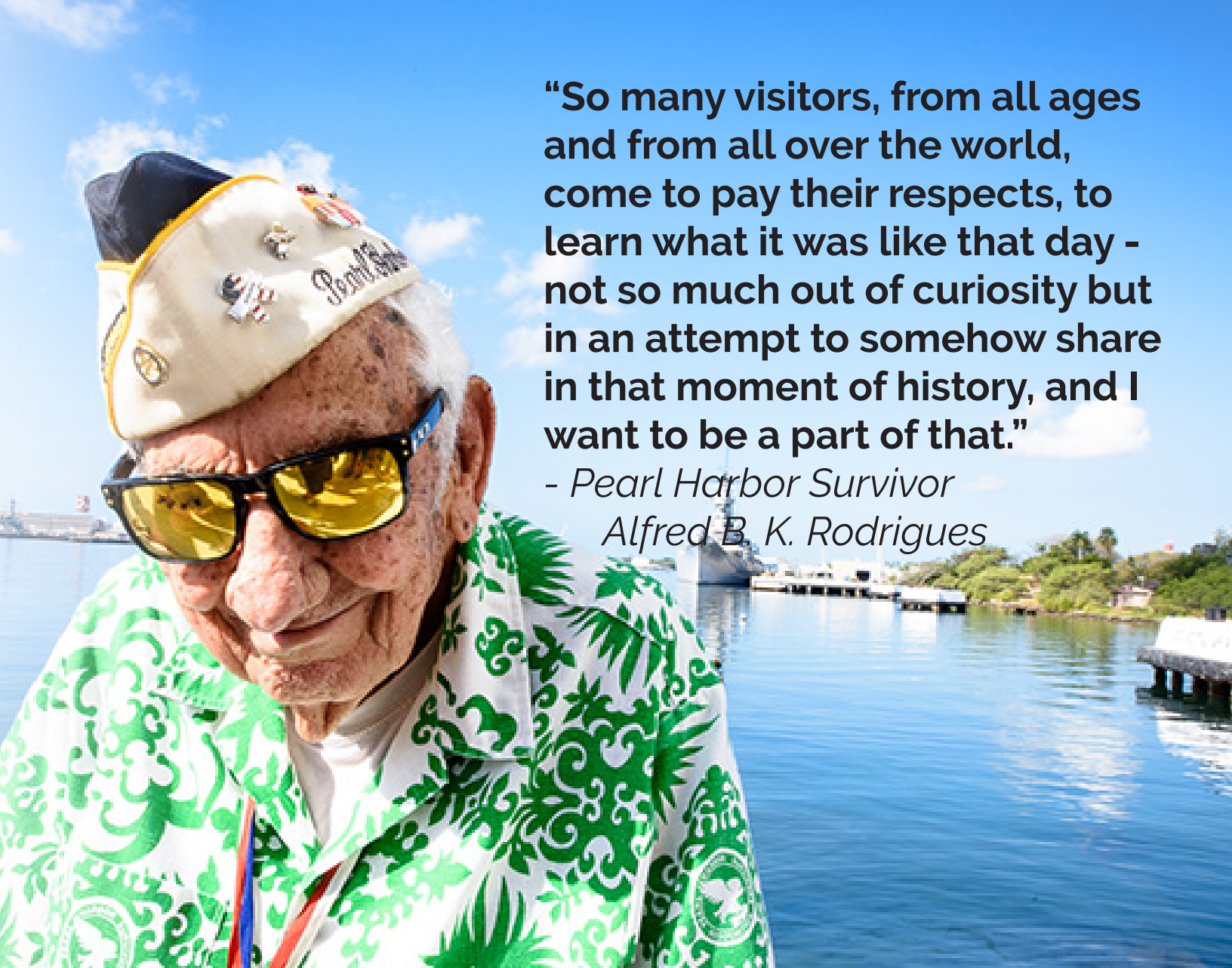
We do this with our education programs – Junior Ranger Academy, Reef Ranger Camp, River Ranger Environmental Education, Arts in the Park, Ticket to Ride, Every Kid in the Park initiative and Teacher Workshops and Institutes.

Kalaupapa National Historical Park has a long-standing restriction against entry for anyone under the age of 16. How can we engage local Molokai children in the powerful story of Kalaupapa? We bring the park to the people! Over three days, staff packed up their gear and engaged over 240 students in hands on activities, demonstrations, a hike and a field trip to bring the Kalaupapa story alive.

PHP conserves critical resources, such as the preservation of grave markers of thousand of patients who lived in Kalaupapa, rehabilitation of the Pali Trail, and by providing an outdoor classroom shelter for students unable to visit the settlement.

PHP also supports various programs, such as fulfilling the one true wish of a child with life threatening medical conditions. Our partnership with Make A Wish Hawaii gives kids an escape from the reality of their illness. In 2017, we were given the privilege to fulfill the wish of 204 children and their families with a visit to Pearl Harbor. It's truly amazing how much magic is in that all powerful wish and what an honor it is to make that wish a reality.

Through our "Rendezvous with History" oral history program, our legacy – the Pearl Harbor Survivors and World War II Veterans – have an opportunity to share their legacies and inspire future generations by capturing these stories.

Restoration of the Court of Honor and Flag Circle Memorial, which were damaged when Saipan took a direct hit from Super Typhoon Soudelor, were completed.

Honouliuli National Monument, a place of detention during World War II in Hawaii, is now a place to reflect on wartime experiences and recommit to the pursuit of freedom and justice. Partnering with internment sites regionally, as well as the Japanese Cultural Center of Hawaii, NPS staff at VALR are creating the Foundation Document to identify the purpose, significance, key interpretive themes, and fundamental resources. This document will provide a strategic “road map” to ensure that all work will honor the multifaceted history of Honouliuli National Monument.

Pacific Historic Parks values the importance of history – it needs to be protected, researched, preserved, and passed on to future generations.

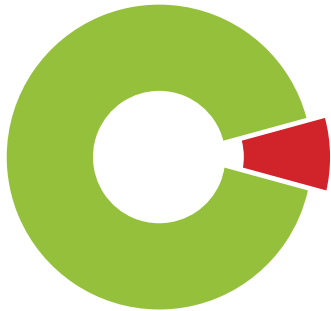

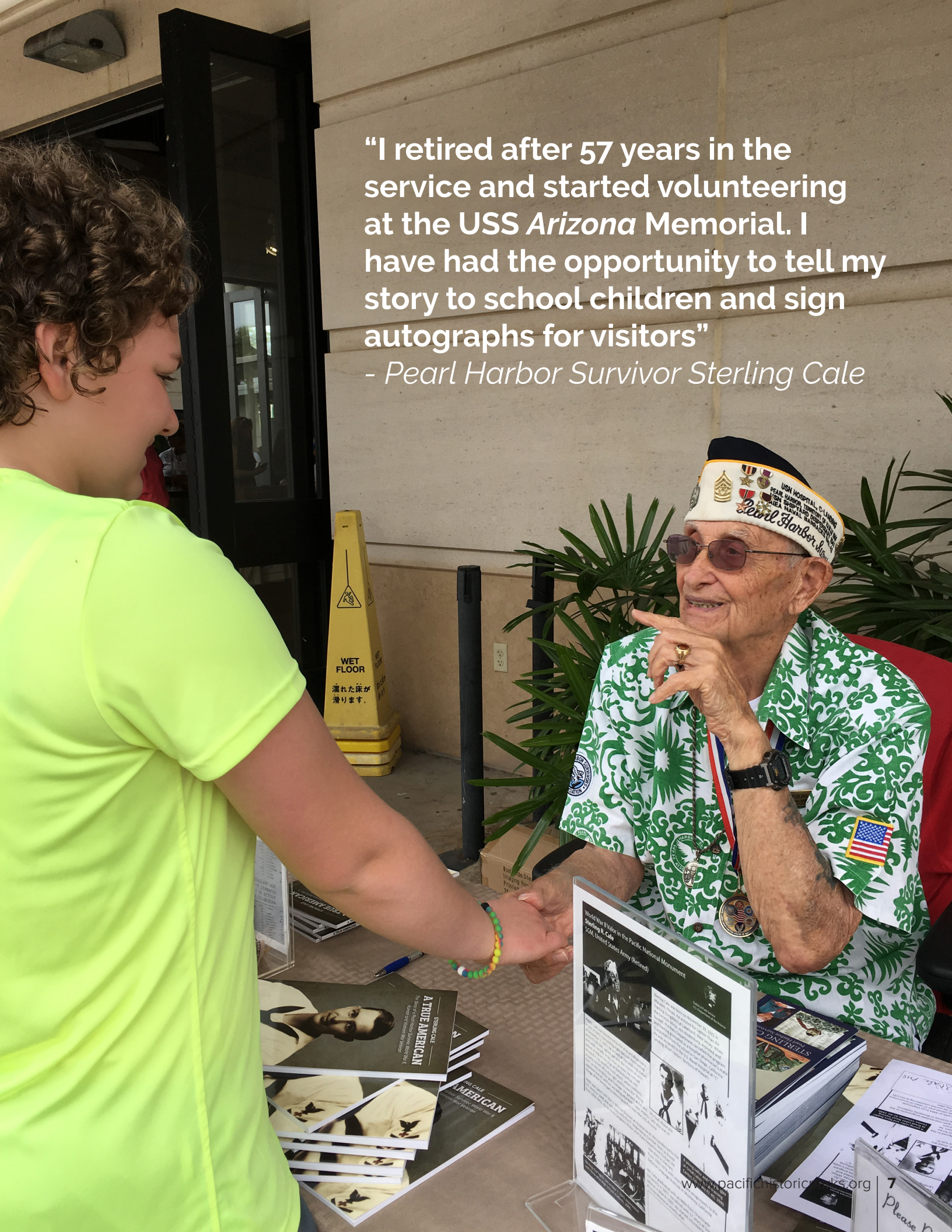
