## Asan Bay Overlook Memorial Wall Stone Rubbing Teacher Guide

### Supply List

- Printed Stone Rubbing Sheets
- Pencil Sharpeners
- Pencils
- Tape

1. Direct students to select a name on the Asan Bay Overlook Memorial Wall.
2. Demonstrate how to make a stone rubbing by placing the Stone Rubbing Sheet over the name you selected to be transferred.
3. Use a small strip of tape to attach the Stone Rubbing Sheet to the memorial wall. This will help to keep the sheet in place.
4. Hold a pencil so that the broad side of pencil lead (not just the tip) is against the sheet. This will be at about a 20-degree angle or less.
5. Gently rub or drag the broad side of the pencil lead over the surface of sheet.
6. Continue rubbing until the darkness and shading of the image on your Stone Rubbing Sheet is legible.
7. Gently remove the tape from the memorial wall and the Stone Rubbing Sheet. Dispose of the tape.
